

150 Pouch Bag

Size 44 x 25 cm (17 1/4 x 10 ins)

Materials

Print batiste,

width: 120 cm (47 ins)
length: 0.55 m (3/4 yd) of green,

0.55 m (3/4 yd) of pink,

and 0.75 m (7/8 yd) of yellow, for lining.

Recommended fabrics: Cotton fabrics.

Preparations

Follow the diagram to make a full-size paper pattern piece for the bag.

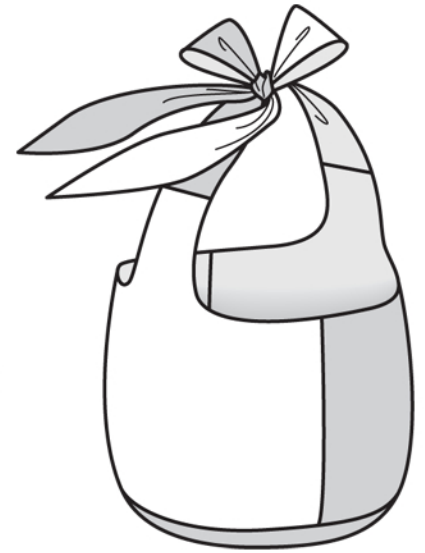
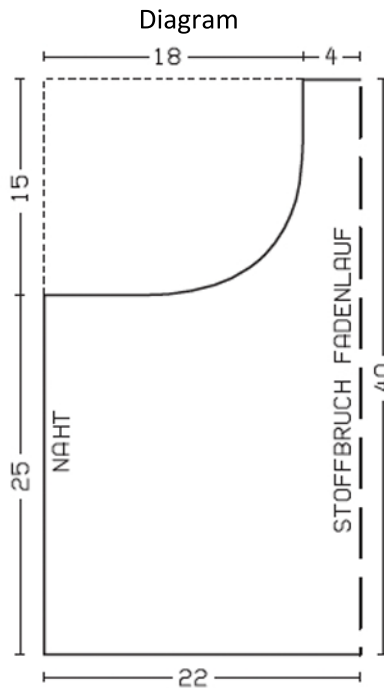
Also draft the following pieces:

b) 1 round bottom piece, \varnothing 28 cm (11 1/8 ins),

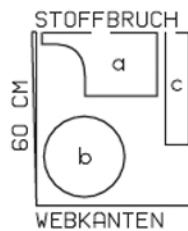
c) 1 strap piece, 78 cm (30 3/4 ins) long, 8 cm (3 1/4 ins) wide.

Seam allowances:

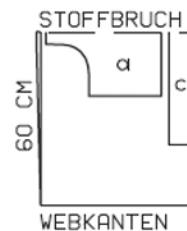
Seams and edges 1 cm (3/8 in).



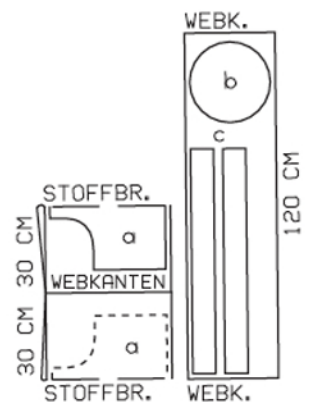
Green



Pink



Yellow (lining)



Stoffbruch = fabric fold
Webkanten = selvage

Cut pieces a, b and c on a double layer of fabric. Use fabric with a width of 120cm.

Cutting Out

Green fabric:

- a) bag piece (diagram) 1x, on a fold,
- b) 1 round bottom piece
- c) 1 strap piece

Pink fabric:

pieces a and c.

Yellow fabric (lining):

pieces a and c each 2x, and piece b.

Sewing

Stitch all the bag pieces together, right sides together. Press seam allowances open. Stitch the bottom piece to the lower edge of the bag pieces. Press seam allowances onto bottom piece. Stitch strap pieces to narrow ends of bag pieces (alternate colours). Press seam allowances open.

Stitch seams of lining, leaving an opening, approx. 10 cm (4 ins) long, at centre, for turning. Sew bottom in place.

Turn lining right side out. Lay lining in bag, right sides facing, laying strap pieces together. Trim strap ends at an angle. Stitch along bag edges and along edges of straps, as continuous seam. Trim allowances, trimming corners diagonally. Clip curves several times.

Pull lining out of bag and turn right side out, through seam opening. Sew opening closed. Lay lining in bag. Topstitch close to edges of bag and straps. Knot straps together.
