

### 103 Fur Collar

One Size

### Materials

**Fake fur,**  
width: 140 cm (55 ins)  
length: 0.60 m (3/4 yd) or a piece 60 x 50 cm (24 x 20 ins).

**Satin, for lining**  
width: 140 cm (55 ins)  
lining: 0.60 m (3/4 yd).

Vilene/Pellon G 700.

Petersham ribbon, 1.5 cm (5/8 in) wide and 1.20 m (1 3/8 yds) long.

**Recommended fabrics:** Fake fur. Satin for the lining.

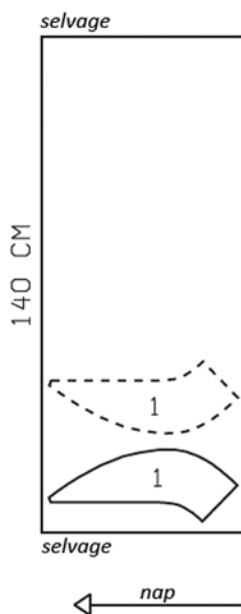
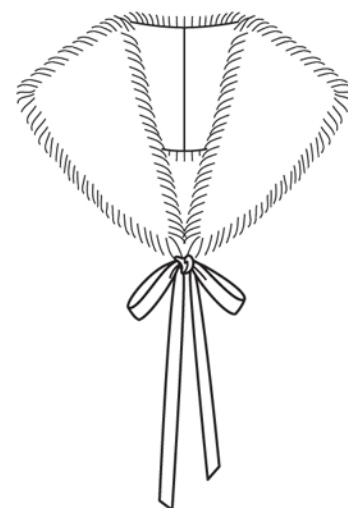
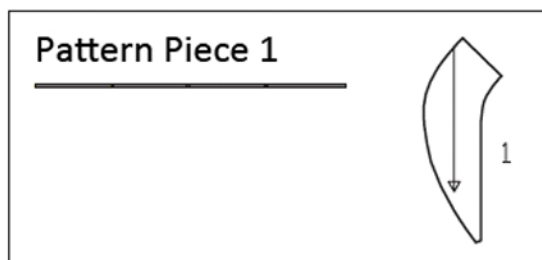
### Preparations

Print the pattern out on letter or A4 sized paper. It is **very** important to not scale or fit any of the pages, you must print the document in **actual size**. Your pattern will print on multiple pages, which you will then tile together. Arrange the sheets on a large, hard and flat surface matching up the numbers and letters (i.e. 6A to 6A). Cut or fold one of the sides and match the edge to it's corresponding side. Then, tape down in place so paper is secure.

Trace the pattern piece from the pattern sheet.

**burda style magazine patterns do not have seam allowance included.**

To be added:  
Seams and edges 1.5 cm (5/8 in).



Cut from a single layer of fabric, wrong side facing up. Note direction of nap. When cutting fake fur, cut only the backing fabric and not the pile fibres. Use fabric with a width of 140cm.

### Cutting Out

**Fake fur/lining:**

1 collar 2x

**Interfacing:** Iron interfacing to wrong side of lining pieces.

### Sewing

On fur collar, stitch centre back seam, pushing pile fibres toward centre of piece. Spread seam open and sew in place, with herringbone stitch. Stitch centre seam of collar lining, leaving approx. 7 cm (3 ins) open in centre of seam, for turning. Press seam open.

Cut petersham ribbon into 2 equal pieces. Baste ribbons to front ends of fur collar. Roll ribbons up and pin to centre of collar (so ends won't be caught in stitching). Stitch lining to fur collar, right sides facing, pushing fibres toward body of collar. Trim seam allowances. Turn collar right side out. Sew seam opening closed. Unpin ribbons.
