

133 Shrug

Burda sizes 34 to 38 and 40 to 44,

Materials

Fake fur,
width: 140 cm (55 ins)
length: 0.70 m (7/8 yd).

Satin lining,
width: 140 cm (55 ins)
length: 0.70 m (7/8 yd).

Recommended fabrics: Fake fur.

Preparations

Draft and cut the following pieces:

Fake Fur:

Draft and cut a rectangle for the body, 130 – 135 cm (51 1/4 – 53 1/4 ins) long and 70 cm (27 3/4 ins) wide.

Lining:

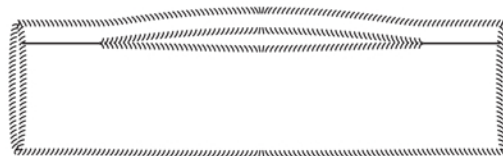
Draft and cut a rectangle, 124 – 129 cm (49 – 50 3/4 ins) long and 67 cm (26 1/2 ins) wide.

These measurements include 3 cm (1 1/4 in) wide seam allowances for the fake fur and 1.5 cm (5/8 in) wide seam allowances for the lining.

Sewing

Fold fur piece in half lengthwise, fur side facing in. Stitch long edges together, 28 cm (11 1/8 ins) long, at each end, stitching 3 cm (1 1/4 ins) from fabric edges. Spread allowances open and hand-sew in place, with herringbone stitch, also sewing allowances on open edges in place with herringbone stitch. Fold lining piece in half lengthwise, right side facing in. Stitch long edges together, 23 cm (9 1/8 ins) long, at each end, stitching 1.5 cm (5/8 in) from fabric edges. Press seam allowances open.

Turn fur piece right side out. Pull lining piece inside fur piece, with wrong sides facing. Now first turn edges of fur and lining under, at seam on one end and pin together with a single straight pin.



Reach through opening in long edge, between fur and lining, to grab pinned edges and pull them out. Remove pin but keep hold of edges. Stitch edges together, 1.5 cm (5/8 in) from edge. Fold 3 cm (1 1/4 ins) wide fur allowance to inside and sew in place with herringbone stitch. Then push edges in place again. At other end, stitch lining in place in same manner.

Turn fur side in (lining side out). Pin seam ends of lining 2 cm (3/4 in) behind seam ends of fur piece. Turn lining edges under and pin approx. 1.5 cm (5/8 in) from fur edges. Sew by hand, tapering stitching toward seam ends. Turn shrug right side out.
