



{cake stand sewing pattern}

Thank you for trying a SWEETIE PIE BAKERY pattern! I hope you find the step-by-step illustrations easy to follow and enjoy the pattern and toys that you produce!

SWEETIE PIE BAKERY

Please, read through all directions before beginning the project!

VOCABULARY

Blind Stitch-a sewing stitch visible on one side.

Right Side-This is the side you would want showing-the softer side, the side without pattern markings

Wrong Side-This is the side you do not want showing-the side that is a bit more rough, the side with pattern markings

SEWING NOTES

When sewing the embroidery stitches (blanket stitch, split stitch, etc.) use 2 strands of embroidery floss unless otherwise stated.

All seam allowances are 1/4" in unless otherwise stated.

Tutorials for stitches can be found in the back of the booklet!

CARE FOR COMPLETED ITEMS

The main thing to note when caring for your felt items is to avoid drastic changes in temperature and rubbing, which will cause pilling.

Dry cleaning 100% wool felts and wool felt blends is recommended.

Surface washing can be done by gently cleaning the area with a baby wipe.

Hand washing is an option for a bit more severe messes. Place the stuffed item in a tub of cold water, and soak it. Pull it out and squeeze all of the water out and repeat until the stain is gone. If you need to worry about disinfecting the toy, add some lemon juice to the water or combine 1/2 part vinegar to 1 part water and clean the same way.

CONSTRUCTION

Cake Stand Base

1) Prepare all pattern pieces

Cut 2 of Base Bottom (Felt A) of felt

Cut 1 of Base Bottom Support (Card stock A) of card stock

Cut 2 of Base Top (Felt B) of felt

Cut 1 of Base Top Support (Card stock B) of card stock

Cut 2 of Base Side (Felt C) of felt

Cut 1 of Base Side Support (Card stock C) of card stock

2) Glue Base Bottom Support (Card A) in between two Base Bottom (Felt A) pieces, right sides out.



3) Glue Base Top Support (Card B) in between two Base Top (Felt B) pieces, right sides out.



4) Glue Base Side Support (Card C) to the wrong side of one Base Side (Felt C)



5) Using a machine, right sides together, sew the diagonal lines of the Base Side (Felt C). Trim excess and turn right side out.



6) Sew the other Base Side (Felt C) with right sides together making sure you sew as close to the card stock as you can. Trim excess.

7) Slide the Base Side (Felt A) over the Base side with the cardstock support make sure to align the seams!



8) Using a blanket stitch, attach the Base Top (Felt B) pieces to the top of the cone.

Now attach the Base Bottom (Felt A) in the same manner.



9) Your base is now complete! Set this aside for now.



Cake Stand Platform

- 10)Cut 2 of Platform Top (Felt D) of felt Cut 1 of Platform Top Support (Foam D) of foam board Cut 2 of Platform Scallop (Felt E) of felt Cut 1 of Platform Scallop Support (Card E) of card stock
- 11) Glue the Platform Top Support (Foam D) in between two Platform Top (Felt D) felt pieces, with right sides facing out.

12) Glue one Scallop Support (Card E) to the wrong side of one Platform Scallop (Felt E).




13) Fold each Platform Scallop piece with right sides together and stitch the shorter ends closed creating a loop Sew as close to the cardstock as possible.




14) Slip the Felt Platform Scallop over the one with the support-make sure to align the seams!



- *Pinning the top of the ring helps hold everything in place while you line up the bottom details!
- 15) Blanket stitch along the bottom edge of the Platform Scallop. Take care to begin and end your stitch at each point for a cleaner look.



16) After you have sewn around the bottom perimeter of the Platform Scallop, fir the edge around the perimeter of the Platform Top.



ASSEMBLY

17) Place a good amount of glue on the Base Top and glue it to the center of the **bottom** of the Platform Top.



18) Your cake stand is now finished! Pile on the goodies and let your little one enjoy your creation!

TUTORIALS

Blanket Stitch

- 1) Begin with knotting your thread. Take your needle and pull it through the felt, just barely catching it and not going through the backside.
- 2) Bring your needle through the front piece of felt and leave a small amount not pulled through.



- 3) Take your needle and weave it through the loop you left out.
- 4) Pull the thread taught.
- 5) Take your needle through the back of the back piece of felt and bring it through the front side, leaving a small loop out.
- 6) Pull your needle through the loop again. Repeat this stitch around your entire piece and knot your thread at the end to secure it.

MATERIALS

WoolFelt® (yardage is for 72" bolts)
Straw-0403, 1/2 yard
1 skeins of DMC embroidery floss
to cooridnate with felt color

SUPPLIES

Poster board-1 20" x 30" sheet
Foam board-1 20" x 30" sheet
Hot Glue Gun and Glue
Scissors
Embroidery Needle
Sewing Machine
Straight Pins
