## Materials

Pete T-Shirt pattern, a bit of ribbing, an overlock machine or alternative

### Step 1

Serge the shoulder seams at 5/8 inch (see related techniques).

### Step 2



Shoulder.

Sleeve Hem.

## Step 4



Pin the sleeves to armholes; serge.

---

## Step 5



Serge the sleeve hems. Turn up hems, and to secure either use a twin needle (see related techniques), or a straight stitch with an elastic thread in the bobbin, or if you are a super lucky goose, your cover stitch machine/the cover stitch option on your fancy

overlock machine.

## Step 6



Serge from the sleeve hems all the way down the side seams to the them.

## Step 7



Serge the hem, and secure as you did the sleeve hems.

---

## Step 8

Serge the shoulder seams at 5/8

---

## Step 9



Rib the neckline (see related techniques).
