

# Steffi altered- take 2 Bolero

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The Steffi jacket pattern altered into a bolero without collar.

## Materials

Denim, Apple cotton fabric, thread

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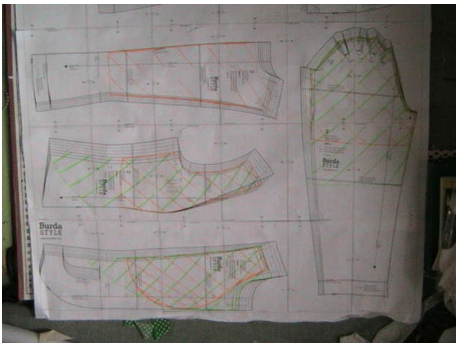
## Step 1



Using the muslin i made for my first Steffi alteration i marked my bolero alteration directly onto it with pencil.

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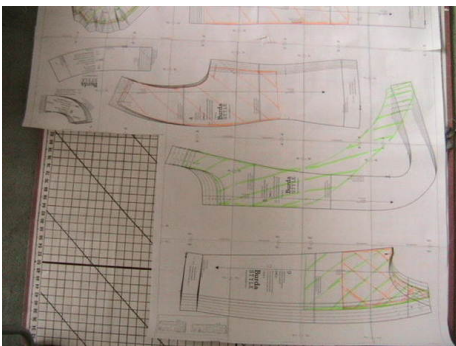
## Step 2



I then cut the muslin and used this to mark the changes on the paper pattern as you see in this photo and the next marked in orange.

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## Step 3



Bolero alterations marked in orange.

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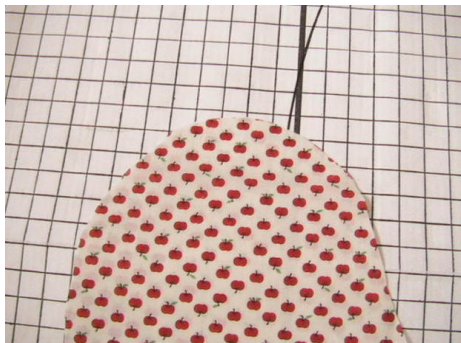
## Step 4



The pattern pinned onto the recycled denim fabric. Cut out and do the same for your lining.

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## Step 5



slightly round off the sleeve pieces of the lining and when making the sleeve gather them rather than folding the pleats.

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## Step 6



Overlock all edges.

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## Step 7



Make the outside and lining of the jacket the same way as is described in from sewing the back and front and inserting the sleeves. No need for facings or a collar. Pin them together right sides facing and sew all around the edge.

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### Step 8



Turn the jacket right sides out, press the seams and top stitch all the way around. I used a blue thread for the denim side and a white thread for the lining side.

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### Step 9



Sew the sleeves closed and fold over to create cuffs.

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## Step 10



Sew a buttonhole and add a button.

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## Step 11



The finished bolero Steffi jacket.
