

Toasty Cardigan Wrap

I found this lovely super-soft fabric and just had to make something for this upcoming Fall and Winter! The belt is detachable, and even has my name embroidered in the middle. Turned out pretty good.

Materials

I printed out the Andrew pattern form this site, but altered it a bunch and turned it into a wrap style rather than a buttoned cardigan.

Step 1 — PRINT ANDREW PATTERN, ALTER

First, print out the Andrew pattern and alter it to fit your size. I added a more fitted curved shape in the body, but I would do even more next time. I also trimmed a decent amount of the sleeves at the top half of the arm, so that the sleeves would look more feminine and fitted. You will also need to cut a 3 yard by 5 inch rectangle for your belt.

Step 2 — CUT & SEW AS IN PATTERN, MAKE BELT

Cut and sew all the pieces minus the extra rectangle that was not part of the pattern. Then take the large belt-piece, fold it in half (good sides facing) and pin so that it is now 2.5 inches by 3 yards, and sew along the three yards length with a 5/8 inch seam allowance. Leave both ends open for turning. Use a safety pin and turn the long belt tube right-side out. Tuck in the ends an inch and and top stitch to close. Top stitch along entire perimeter. Then I embroidered my name with my sewing machine. Finish, clip threads.
