

# How to make a bow (parisienne)

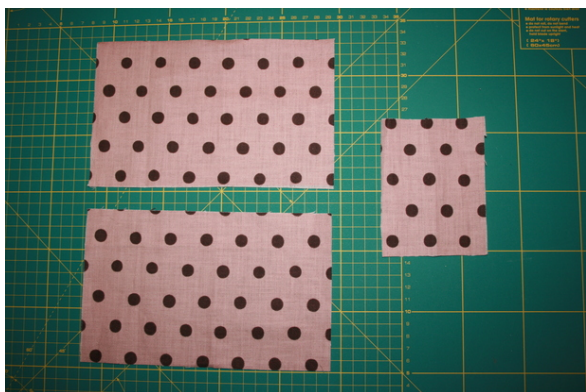
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Maybe some of you remember my project called "Go Parisienne"? I was asked by several other members to do a "How-To" for the bow. Here it is! Hope you enjoy it. :)

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## Step 1 — Cut the fabric pieces



The bow of this "How To" is smaller than the one I used for my skirt. Simply adjust the size of the pattern pieces as you like. The pieces here are 13x21cm (2 pieces) and 8x10cm (1piece). 1cm allowance is included.

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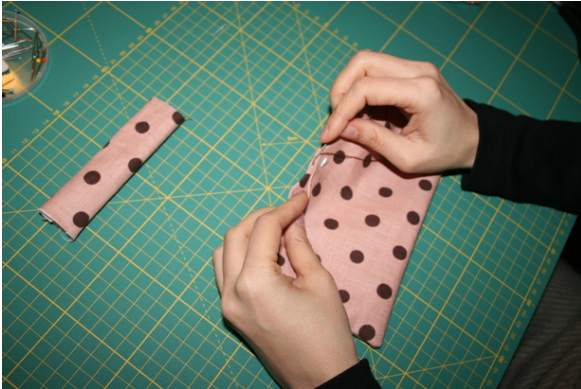
## Step 2 — Sew



Sew the 2 big pieces (right side on right side) together, but leave a small open space. This is needed, so that you can afterwards turn the inside out. Also fold the smaller piece and sew the length.

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### Step 3 — Turn the inside out



Next simply turn the inside out. Then blind stitch the opening of the bigger piece.

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### Step 4 — Make a ring



Sew the ends of the smaller piece together, so that it turns into a ring. Then turn the allowance inside.

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### Step 5 — Pull through



Simply pull the bigger piece through the ring. Arrange your bow and if you like, fix the ring to the bigger piece with some stitches.

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### Step 6 — Finish
