

# Owl Pillow Pattern

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I enlarged my Mini Owl Ornament pattern to create a bigger one. This one is child-friendly with eyes and a beak made out of yarn that roughly measures 8×10

## Materials

Cotton, Poly-fill, Yarn

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### Step 1 — Cut Pattern + Trace



Tape together the triangle piece to the rectangle. Use two contrasting fabrics (solid colors looks best for belly). Place the right side of the fabrics facing the inside and trace the pattern.

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## Step 2 — Sew



Pin your pieces together and sew along the pattern you traced. Do not sew along the bottom.

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## Step 3 — Trim



Trim along your sewn edge leaving .5" edge. Cut off the tip of the triangle on the top as well.

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#### Step 4 — Mark the Eyes



Fold inside out and fold down the top of the triangle. Place the eye pattern on the owl and mark the corners where you want the eyes to be.

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#### Step 5 — Eyes and Beak





Use black yarn and a yarn needle to sew the eyes with a basic satin stitch. Repeat the stitch with orange or yellow yarn so the end of the triangle is attached to the body. Be careful not to stitch through to the back piece.

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### Step 6 — Stuff it



Stuff the owl with poly-fill or a stuffing of your choice.

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### Step 7 — Sew the Bottom



Fold in the bottom of the fabric at least an inch. Double thread your needle and use a running stitch to sew all the way around the bottom.

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## Step 8 — Finish



Slowly pull your stitch together until the bottom is closed off and knot together. Be careful not pull too hard or your thread will break.

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
