

# How to make a 3d corner - quick method

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Let's say you're making a bag but you want it to be box-like (not flat) and you want to do it quickly! Then this is the technique for you!

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## Step 1 — Fold fabric in half and sew one edge



Fold your rectangle of fabric in half, right sides facing. Sew along one open edge in order to close it off.

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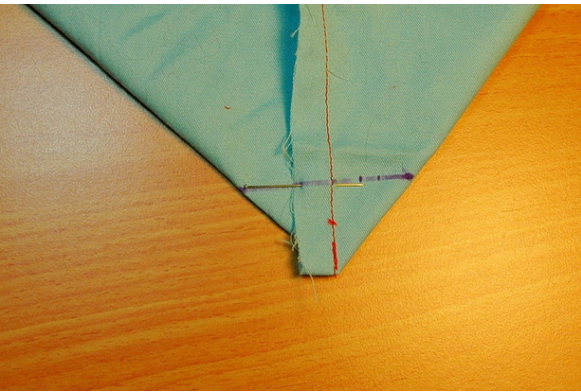
## Step 2 — Prepare the corner



Pull open the fabric and lay it back down so that the seam you just sewed is aligned exactly on top of the fold you initially made. You will get an "arrow" shape (or a triangle shape), like in the photo.

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### **Step 3 — Mark and pin along the corner**



Mark a line across this corner. Measure the same distance from the point in order to make it straight. Choose whichever length suits you. Pin along the marked line.

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### **Step 4 — Sew along the line**



Sew along the line you just marked, removing the pins as you go along. Be sure to tack your seams at the beginning and end of the seam, as always, so they won't come undone.

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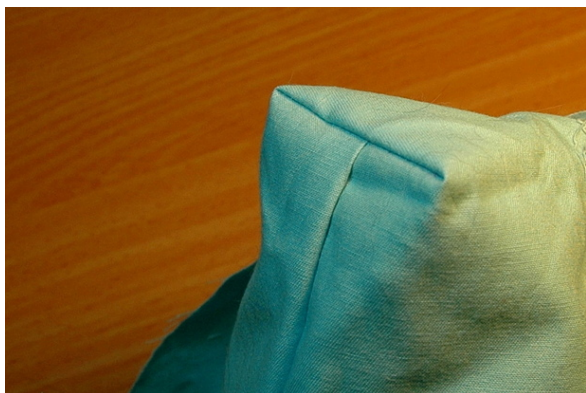
## Step 5 — The sewn line



This is what it looks like after you sewed that line...

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## Step 6 — Done!



Turn it right side out and you're done! You will probably want to trim the excess fabric from the inside first, but you don't have to. Iron your seams so they are nice and crisp (sorry, my iron is still in repair!). That's it!!

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
