

Howto use Japanese thimble vol.1

*Protect the maker's hands and fingers from injury and irritation from the eye of the needle *Provide extra force; much easier to push the needle against something. *make your sewing box looking gorgeous.

Step 1 — Wear the thimble



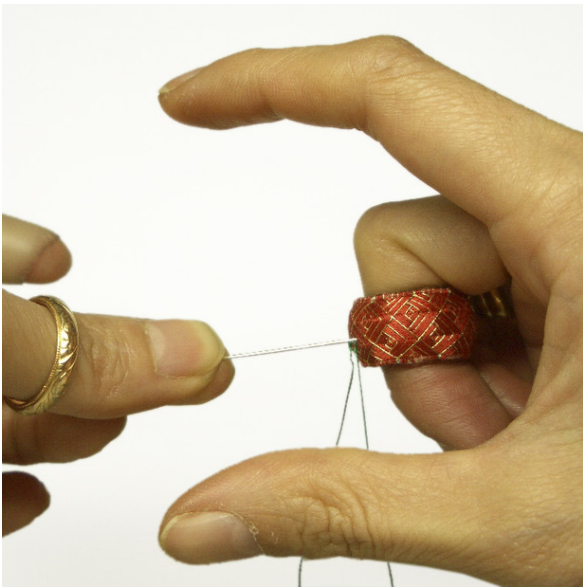
Wear the thimble on just above the knuckle of the middle finger of your sewing hand. * Thimble should be sized to fit snugly between first and second knuckles of the middle finger of the sewing hand.

Step 2 — Fold your fingers



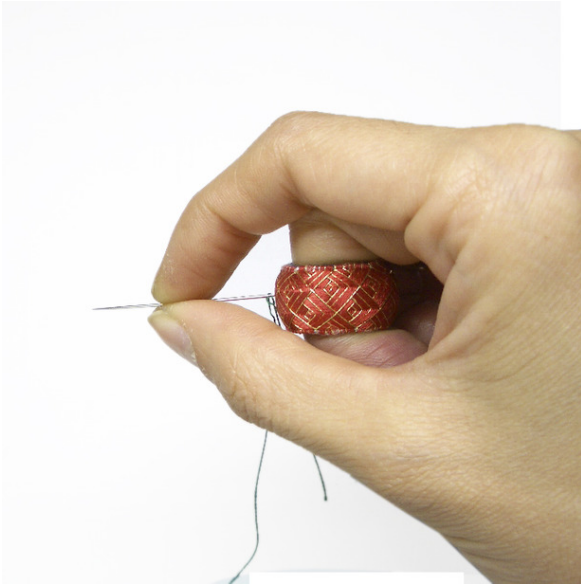
Fold your fingers lightly like picture.

Step 3 — take a needle



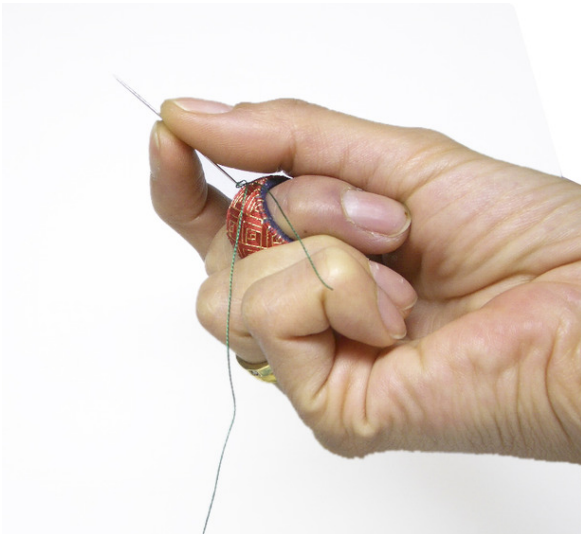
Place the eye of the needle perpendicular to the thimble.

Step 4 — Grasp the tip of the needle



Grasp the tip of the needle with the thumb and forefinger.

Step 5 — basic position
