Sewing in the Round...Beginner's Tip!

This is just a tip, but a very important one for the beginner. When sewing in the round, like hemming a sleeve, after pressing and pinning the hem in place, position the sleeve so the Right side is facing out. Sew within the "tunnel" of the sleeve. This way, there is absolutely no chance you will accidentally catch the rest of the sleeve under the needle. The finished shirt is on BurdaStyle and on my blog

Step 1 — Flip Sleeve Right side out



Sleeve is sewn with right side out so only the correct layer(s) or fabric are going to be stitched. Sew it like this:

Step 2 — This is the Wrong Way!



Don't sew it like this:

Step 3 — Or this Will Happen!



Oh No! You caught the rest of the sleeve under the needle and have to rip out the stitches!

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
