




Long sleeve girlÂ's dirndl burda style magazine patterns FAQ

Materials

Linen, jacquard

Step 1 — Preparation



Paper cut for ANSI A (German DIN A4) prints:â"a"a"This pattern is printed on 8.5 × 11 sheets of plain paper. Do not scale or center pages before printing. Wait until all sheets are printed out before beginning to tape them together. **Do not cut out pattern pieces yet**— Arrange the sheets on a large, hard, flat surface so that they fit together, matching up like numbers and letters (i.e. 6A to 6A). To tape pattern together, fold under the margin of one piece (6A) and tape right against the line of it's matching number/letter (6A). â"a"burda style magazine pattern do not have seam allowance included.â"Seam and hem allowances to be added: Seams and edges 1.5 cm (5/8 in). â"a"see example here: HYPERLINK "http://www.burdastyle.com/projects/072011-jumpsuit/instructions/1" \t "_blank" http://www.burdastyle.com/projects/072011-jumpsuit/instructions/1

Step 2 — Cutting out

Materials 2



Dress

Linen:

1â"-front 2x

2â"-front band 2x

3â"back, on a fold 1x

4â"-sleeve 2x

- a) bias strip for neck edge, 38 â" 39 â" 40 â" 41 â" 41 cm (15 â" 151/2 â" 153/4 â" 161/4 -161/4 ins) long, 4 cm (15/8 ins) wide (incl. allowances),
- b) 2 sleeve bands, 21 â" 21.5 â" 22 â" 22.5 â" 23.5 cm (83/8 â" 81/2 â" 83/4 â" 9 â" 91/4 ins) long, 8 cm (31/4 ins) wide, finished width 4 cm (15/8 ins),
- c) 2 skirt panels, 98 â" 100 â" 102 â" 103 â" 107 cm (383/4 â" 391/2 â" 401/4 â" 403/4 â" 421/4 ins) wide, 28 â" 30 â" 32 â" 34 â" 36 cm (111/8 â" 12 â" 123/4 â" 131/2 â" 141/4 ins) long, d) front slit facing, 11 cm (43/8 ins) long, 3 cm (11/4 ins) wide (incl. allowances).

Batiste:

e) 2 underskirt panels, 98 â" 100 â" 102 â" 103 â" 107 cm (383/4 â" 391/2 â" 401/4 â" 403/4 â" 421/4 ins) wide, 33 â" 34 â" 36 â" 38 â" 40 cm (13 â" 131/2 â" 141/4 â" 15 â" 153/4 â" ins) long.

Apron

Jacquard:

- f) apron, 40 cm (153/4 ins) wide, 32 â" 34 â" 36 â" 38 â" 40 cm (123/4 â" 131/2 â" 141/4 â" 15 â" 153/4 ins) long, including 6 cm (23/8 ins) for hem,
- g) waistband, 20 cm (8 ins) long, 4 cm (11/2 ins) wide, finished width 2 cm (3/4 in),
- h) 2 sashes, 95 â" 100 â" 100 â" 105 â" 105 cm (38 â" 40 â" 40 â" 42 â" 42 ins) long, 5.5 cm (21/4 ins) wide.

Step 3 — Seam and shoulder

Stitch side seams and shoulder seams of bodice. Press seams open.

Step 4 — Neck edge

Press bias strip lengthwise, right side facing out. Pin folded bias strip to neck edge so that fold edge lies on garment piece, 1 cm (3/8 in) past seam line, and ends of strip lie on front allowances. Stitch along neck edge. Trim seam allowances. Turn bias strip to inside. Press edge.

Step 5 — Front bands

Stitch front bands to vertical edges of fronts, catching frills. Press seam allowances of band joining seams and of other long edges of bands onto bands. Fold bands on fold line, right side facing in. Stitch across top end. Turn bands right side out and baste inside edges in place. Topstitch bands close to joining seams. Work buttonholes in right band.

Step 6 — Sleeves

Stitch sleeve seams. Fold sleeve bands in half lengthwise, right side in. Stitch across ends. Turn bands right side out and press. Stitch edges of bands together to sleeves â" narrow ends meet at marking. Press allowances up. Pin petersham ribbon to sleeve, along band joining seam, turning ends of ribbon under at sleeve seam. Stitch along centre of ribbon.

Step 7 — Sleeve caps

Set in sleeves, easing sleeve caps.

Step 8 — Skirt and underskirt

Stitch side seams of skirt and underskirt. Stitch skirt hem 4 cm (15/8 ins) from edge. Hem underskirt.

Step 9 — Underskirt

Place underskirt inside skirt, right side to wrong side. Baste upper edges together. Baste both layers of fabric together on each side of centre front, approx. 10 cm (4 ins) long, beginning at upper edge, for the slit.

Step 10 — Front slit

Use basting thread to mark a slit, 8 cm (31/4 in) long, in centre of front skirt panel. Pin slit facing right sides together with skirt panel over slit mark. Work from wrong side to stitch closely around marking. Slash between line of stitching. Turn facing to inside. Press edges of slit.

Step 11 — Gather skirt and attach to bodice

Gather upper edge of skirt to match edge of bodice, beginning and ending 2 cm (3/4 in) from each front slit edge. Pin skirt to bodice â" matching front slit edges to band edges and not catching slit facing. At front slit edges, turn facing to outside and pin in place, over front. Stitch skirt to bodice. Turn facing to inside. Turn skirt down. Press seam allowances of skirt joining seam up, from each band joining seam. Topstitch close to slit edges. Fasten slit of skirt with one snap fastener.

Step 12 — Apron

Press allowances on side edges of apron to inside, turn in to 1 cm (3/8 in) wide, and stitch. Turn in allowance on lower edge and stitch 3 cm (11/4 ins) from edge.

Step 13 — Gather

Gather upper edge of apron match waistband. Stitch waistband to upper edge of apron. Press allowances of joining seam and of other long edge of waistband onto waistband. Fold waist- band in half lengthwise and press, wrong side facing in. Unfold again.

Step 14 — Sashes

On each sash, turn allowances of long edges to wrong side, turn raw edges under, and stitch. Fold one end of each sash lengthwise, right side facing in, and stitch across end. Trim seam allowances and neaten. Turn end of sash right side out, to a point, and press. Make folds in straight ends of sashes and baste to ends of outer half of waistband. Fold waistband half to outside and stitch across ends. Turn waistband right side out. Baste inside edge in place. Topstitch waistband close to ends and close to joining seam.

Step 15 — Sashes

On each sash, turn allowances of long edges to wrong side, turn raw edges under, and stitch. Fold one end of each sash lengthwise, right side facing in, and stitch across end. Trim seam allowances and neaten. Turn end of sash right side out, to a point, and press. Make folds in straight ends of sashes and baste to ends of outer half of waistband. Fold waistband half to outside and stitch across ends. Turn waistband right side out. Baste inside edge in place. Topstitch waistband close to ends and close to joining seam.

Step 16 — Fabric flowers

For each flower cut 2 circles of leftover batiste, approx. 5 cm (2 ins) in diameter. Lay 2 circles together, right sides facing. Stitch together, 5 mm (3/16 in) from edge, leaving an opening for turning. Turn circle right side out and stuff. Sew opening closed. Make 5 petals, evenly spaced, by making a straight stitch, from centre to edge, and pulling it tightly toward centre. Sew a bead to centre of flower. Sew pieces of ribbon and narrow cord of various lengths to underside of flower. Attach flowers to brooch pin and pin to dress or sew them in place, without a pin.

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
