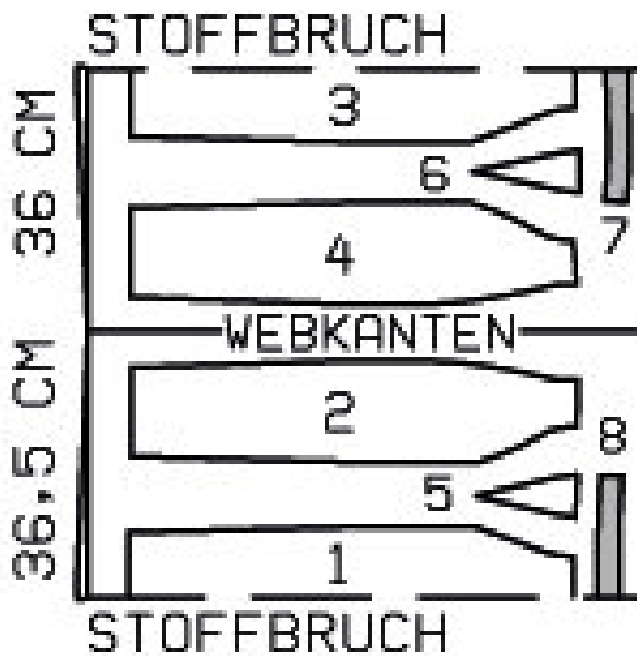

## Materials

Wool gabardine

---

## Step 1 — Preparation



124 A 17-21

\*PATTERN DOES NOT INCLUDE SEAM ALLOWANCE

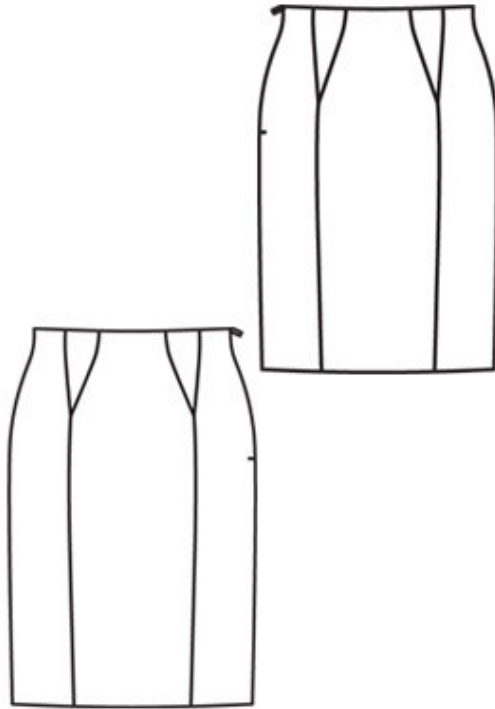
Trace the pattern pieces from the pattern sheet. Follow lines and details for views A and B.

Seam and hem allowances:

Seams and edges 1.5 cm (5/8 in), hem 4 cm (15/8 ins).

## Step 2 — Cutting Out



1â—centre front skirt panel,

â— â—on a fold 1x

2â—side front skirt panel 2x

3â—centre back skirt panel,

â— â—on a fold 1x

4â—side back skirt panel 2x

5â—front insert 2x

6â—back insert 2x

7â—front facing, on a fold 1x

8â—back facing, on a fold 1x

Interfacing: Iron onto facing pieces.

## Step 3 — Front Seams

Stitch front section seams from marking (seam number 1) to slit mark, back section seams from marking (seam number 2) to lower edge. Stitch inserts to skirt panel edges above markings, note seam numbers. Press

seam allowances of joining seams onto skirt panels, press seam allowances of section seams open.

---

## **Step 4 — Side Seams and Zipper**

Stitch right side seam. Sew invisible zip to left opening edges. Stitch left side seam from lower edge to zip.

---

## **Step 5 — Facing**

Stitch right side seam of facing (as mirror image of skirt). Pin facing right sides together with upper edge of skirt. Turn ends of facing at zip opening back 5 mm (3/16 in) before edge, pin to upper edge. Lay allowances of skirt at edges of opening outward and pin to upper edge over facing. Stitch along upper edge of skirt. Turn allowances at edges of opening to inside. Lay facing up and stitch to seam allowances, close to seam, as far as possible. Turn facing to inside, sew to zip tapes. Sew lower edge of facing on at seams.

---

## **Step 6 — Hem Allowances**

Press hem allowance to inside and sew by hand.
