

# 6/2010 Girl's dress with full skirt

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Girl's dress with full skirt burda style magazine patterns FAQ

## Materials

Batiste

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## Step 1 — Preparation

Trace the pattern pieces from the pattern sheet.

The buttonholes on piece 2 are marked for size 110. For sizes 116 â' 134, mark the top buttonhole the same distance from upper edge as for size 110. The bottom buttonhole is in the same place for all sizes. Space the other buttonholes evenly in between.

Diagram:

Follow the diagram to make a fullsized pattern piece each for the skirt panel (a) and the underskirt panel (b) as follows:

On a large sheet of wrapping paper the upper edge and the right edges must form a right angle stretch a thread from the upper right corner to mark the radius for the waist edge and the hem lines of the skirt (R1) and underskirt (R2). Mark the hem facing and trace as a separate pattern piece.

Seam and hem allowances:

Seams and edges 1.5 cm (5/8 in), sleeve hems 3 cm (1 1/4 ins), no allowance on lower edge of tulle frills.

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## Step 2 — Cutting Out



Batiste:

1 front 2x

2 front band 2x

3 back, on a fold 1x

4 collar, on a fold 2x

6 sleeve 2x

a) skirt panel from diagram, twice, on a fold,

c) hem facing from diagram, twice, on a fold,

d) bias strip for neck edge, 36" 36" 37" 37" 38 cm (14 1/4" 14 1/4" 14 1/2" 14 1/2" 15 ins) long, 4 cm (1 5/8 ins) wide (incl. allowance),

e) tie belt, 125 cm (50 ins) long, 8 cm (3 1/4 ins) wide, finished width 4 cm (1 5/8 ins).

Lining:

b) underskirt panel from diagram, twice, on a fold.

Tulle:

upper frill, a total of 400" 410" 420" 430" 440 cm (157 1/2" 161 1/2" 165 1/2" 169 1/2" 173 1/2 ins) long, 13" 14" 15.5" 16.5" 18 cm (5 1/4" 5 1/2" 6 1/4" 6 1/2" 7 ins)

wide, bottom frill, a total of 400 â 410 â 420 â 430 â 440 cm (157 1/2 â 161 1/2 â 165 1/2 â 169 1/2 â 173 1/2 ins) long, 17â 18 â 19.5 â 20.5 â 22 cm (6 3/4 â 7 â 7 3/4 â 8 1/4 â 8 3/4 ins) wide.

Interfacing: See pattern layout.

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### **Step 3 — Front bands**

Stitch front bands to fronts. Press seam allowances of band joining seams and of other long edges of bands onto bands.

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### **Step 4 — Stitch shoulder seams**

Stitch shoulder seams. Neaten seam allowances together and press onto back.

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### **Step 5 — Collar pieces**

Stitch collar pieces right sides together along outer edges. Trim seam allowances. Turn collar right side out and press. Topstitch close to edges. Baste edges of collar together to neck edge.

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### **Step 6 — Bias strips**

Fold front bands on fold line, right side facing in. Pin edges together at the top. Fold bias strip for neck edge lengthwise and press, right side facing out. Pin doubled bias strip to neck edge, over collar so that fold edge of strip lies on garment piece, 1 cm (3/8 in) past seam line and ends of strip lie on front bands. Stitch along upper edges of bands and neck edge. Trim seam allowances. Lay bias strip at neck edge to inside and turn front bands right side out. Baste inside edges in place. Topstitch bands close to joining seam and front edge. Topstitch neck edge 7 mm (1/4 in) from collar joining seam, beginning and ending stitching at band joining seams.

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### **Step 7 — Buttonholes**

Work buttonholes in right front band. Lay right band on left band, matching centres. Baste bottom ends of bands together.

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### **Step 8 — Stitch right side seams of dress bodice, skirt, and underskirt.**

Stitch right side seams of dress bodice, skirt, and underskirt. Lay skirt on underskirt, with wrong side facing right side. Baste upper edges together and gather to fit lower edge of bodice. Stitch skirt to bodice. Press seam allowances up.

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### **Step 9 — Zipper**

For the zip opening, measure 10 â 10 â 9 â 8 â 7 cm (4 â 4 â 3 1/2 â 3 1/4 â 3 ins) down from skirt joining seam and mark end of opening. Baste underskirt edges to skirt edges for the length of the opening. Sew invisible zip to left opening edges. Leave top ends of zip tapes unattached. Teeth of zip begin at slit mark. Clip seam allowances of main fabric at bottom of opening. Stitch left side seam above zip. Stitch left side seam of skirt and underskirt each separately below zip.

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## **Step 10 — Hem**

Stitch side seams of hem facing. Stitch hem facing right sides together with lower edge of skirt. Trim seam allowances. Lay facing down and stitch to seam allowances, close to seam. Turn facing to inside and baste. Topstitch 4.5 cm (17/8 ins) from hem edge.

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## **Step 11 — Frills**

Stitch pieces for each frill together. Lay frills one on the other. Baste upper edges together and gather. Stitch frills to lower edge of underskirt. Press seam allowances up.

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## **Step 12 — Sleeves**

Stitch sleeve seams. Press sleeve hem allowances to inside, turn in and stitch 1.5 cm (5/8 in) wide.

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## **Step 13 — Sleeve caps**

Set in sleeves, easing sleeve caps.

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## **Step 14 — Tie belt**

Fold tie belt lengthwise, right side facing in. Trim ends at an angle. Stitch edges stitch together, leaving a section of seam open for turning. Turn belt right side out. Sew seam opening closed.

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
