Step 1 — Preparation



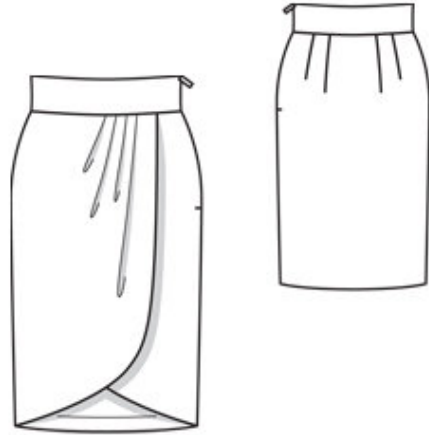
Paper cut for ANSI A (German DIN A4) prints:

This pattern is printed on 8.5 × 11 sheets of plain paper. Do not scale or center pages before printing. Wait until all sheets are printed out before beginning to tape them together. **Do not cut out pattern pieces yet**— Arrange the sheets on a large, hard, flat surface so that they fit together, matching up like numbers and letters (i.e. 6A to 6A). To tape pattern together, fold under the margin of one piece (6A) and tape right against the line of it's matching number/letter (6A).

burda style magazine pattern do not have seam allowance included.

Seam and hem allowances to be added: Seams and edges 1.5 cm (5/8 in).

Step 2 — Cutting out



21—right front skirt panel 1x
—'—'—right front facing 1x
22—left front skirt panel 1x
—'—'—left front facing 1x
23—back skirt panel, on a fold 1x
—'—'—back facing, on a fold 1x
24—front waistband, on a fold 2x
25—back waistband, on a fold 2x
Interfacing: See pattern layout.

Step 3 — Darts

Stitch darts. Press darts toward centre.

Step 4 — Facings

Pin facings right sides together with skirt panels. Stitch along hem and front edges. Trim seam allowances. Turn facings forward/down and stitch to seam allowances, close to seam. On front edges, turn facing to inside and baste to upper edge.

Step 5 — Pleats

Lay pleats in right front skirt panel in direction of arrows and baste to upper edge. Lay right front skirt panel on left front skirt panel to meet abutting line, with wrong side facing right side. Baste in place.

Step 6 — Hem

Stitch right side seam and stitch hem facings together. Press seam allowances open.

Step 7 — Waistband

Stitch right side seams on waistband units, stitching seam of inside waistband as mirror image. Stitch outer waistband to upper edge of skirt. Press seam allowances onto waistband.

Step 8 — Zip

Sew invisible zip to outer half of waistband and to left slit edges. Stitch left side seam from lower edge to zip. Trim bottom of zip approx. 2 cm (3/4 in) below slit and bind with a scrap of fabric.

Step 9 — Waistband

Lay inside waistband right sides together with attached waistband. At zip opening, turn inside waistband back, approx. 5 mm (3/16 in) before edge of opening, and pin to upper edge. On skirt, turn allowances at edges of slit to outside and pin to upper edge, over inside waistband. Stitch along upper edge of waistband. Turn allowances at slit edges to inside and turn waistband right side out. Lay inside waistband flat over joining seam and pin in place. Sew to zip tapes. Work from right side to stitch along line of waistband joining seam, thereby catching inner edge.

Step 10 — Facing

At lower edge of skirt, turn facing to inside. Sew inside facing edge in place by hand.

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
