

# 10/2011 Plus size wool pencil skirt

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Wool skirt burda style magazine patterns FAQ

## Materials

Brushed wool fabric

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## Step 1 — Preparation



Paper cut for ANSI A (German DIN A4) prints:

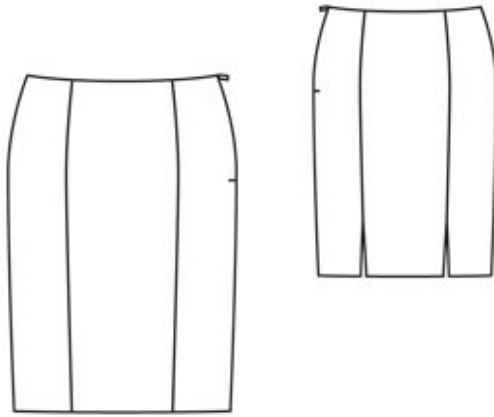
This pattern is printed on 8.5 × 11 sheets of plain paper. Do not scale or center pages before printing. Wait until all sheets are printed out before beginning to tape them together. **Do not cut out pattern pieces yet**— Arrange the sheets on a large, hard, flat surface so that they fit together, matching up like numbers and letters (i.e. 6A to 6A). To tape pattern together, fold under the margin of one piece (6A) and tape right against the line of it's matching number/letter (6A).

**burda style magazine pattern do not have seam allowance included.**

Seam and hem allowances to be added: Seams and edges 1.5 cm (5/8 in).

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## Step 2 — Cutting out



Brushed wool:

21centre front skirt panel,

â—'on a fold 1x

22side front skirt panel 2x

23centre back skirt panel,

â—'on a fold 1x

24side back skirt panel 2x

Lining:

pieces 21 to 24 each 13 cm (5<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> ins) shorter at lower edge than the paper pattern piece.

Interfacing: See pattern layout. Iron shaped strips of interfacing, 4 cm (1<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub> ins) wide, to wrong side of upper edges of skirt lining panels.

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### Step 3 — Front sections

Stitch front section seams. Stitch section seams on skirt back, leaving vents open. Stitch right side seam.

Press seam allowances open.

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### Step 4 — Zip

Sew invisible zip to left opening edges. Stitch left side seam from lower edge to zip opening.

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## **Step 5 — Lining**

Stitch seams of lining, leaving opening for zip.

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## **Step 6 — Face upper edge of skirt**

Pin lining to upper edge of skirt, right sides facing. At zip opening, turn lining back, approx. 5 mm (3/16 in) before edge of opening, and pin to upper edge. At opening edges of skirt, turn allowances to outside and pin to upper edge of skirt, over lining. Stitch along upper edge of skirt. Turn allowances at edges of opening to inside. Turn lining up and stitch to seam allowances, as far as possible, close to seam. Turn lining to inside, and sew to zip tapes.

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## **Step 7 — Hem**

Press hem allowance to inside and sew in place by hand. Press self-facings to inside and sew in place, over hem. Hem skirt lining.

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
