Open-collar lambskin jacket burda style magazine patterns FAQ

Materials

Lambskin (outer side leather, inner side wool)

Step 1 — Preparation

Notes on working with lambskin: We recommend you first make up the pattern in muslin. Transfer any required alterations to the paper pattern pieces before cutting out the leather pieces. Avoid basting or unpicking seams since the holes left by the needle may be permanent. Work from the leather side to cut the lambskin. Use scissors, a craft knife or a razor blade to cut just the leather base and not the wool fibres. Trace the pattern pieces from the pattern sheet.

Seam and hem allowances:

No seam allowances on the following edges: section seam edges of side fronts; shoulder seam edges of fronts; lower edges of fronts, back, and sleeves; front edges of fronts; edges of lapels; back neck edge; lower edge of back yoke; and back seam edges of upper sleeve pieces.

Cut remaining edges with 1 cm (3/8 in) wide seam allowances.

Tip: Use tailor's chalk, magic chalk or a vanishing marker to mark the seam allowance on the leather side. Test on a scrap of fabric first.

Step 2 — Cutting Out



- 1centre front 2x
- 2side front 2x
- 3back yoke, on a fold 1x
- 4back, on a fold 1x
- 6upper sleeve 2x
- 7undersleeve 2x

Step 3 — Single-lapped seams

The wool side faces down. Lay edge without seam allowance on allowance of other edge and edgestitch in place. Push the wool fibres back away from the seam.

Step 4 — Back dart line

Cut each back dart along the back dart line, from the lower edge to point of dart. Trim seam allowances on side dart edges to a width of 1 cm (3/8 in). Lay back edges of darts on seam allowances of side dart edges and stitch.

Step 5 — Stitch back yoke to back

Stitch back yoke to back

Step 6 — Fronts and shoulder seams

Stitch centre fronts to section seam edges of side fronts. Lay fronts on back. Stitch shoulder seams.

Step 7 — Side seams

Stitch side seams in the *normal* manner.

Step 8 — Sleeves

Stitch back seam edges of upper sleeves to undersleeves. Stitch front sleeve seams in the *normal* manner.

Step 9 — Set in sleeves

Set in sleeves, easing sleeve caps (right sides facing).

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
