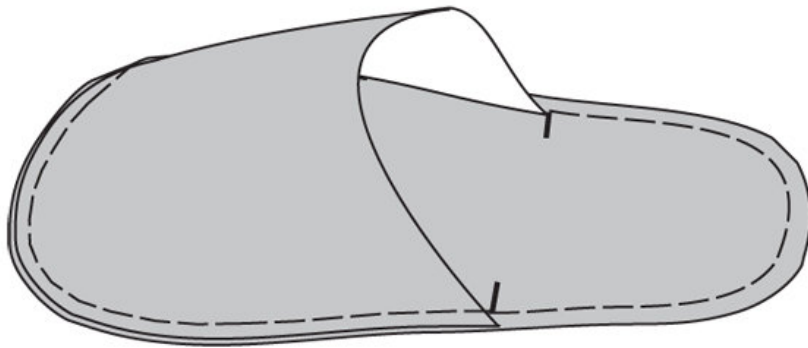


Pushy Alice in Wonderland Slippers for cold winter feet. With those slippers we want to thank Alice to give her name to the last design challenge.

Materials

felt, feathery trim

Step 1



PATTERN

- 1 Sole of slipper 2x
- 2 Upper of slipper 2x

You need

2 mm thick felt

46 inches (114cm) / 56 inches (140 cm) width

Size W-8/9 (EU size 39/40) Instructions

Step 2



Paper cut for ANSI A (German DIN A4) prints:

The patterns are printed out on 4 sheets with a thin frame. Wait, until all sheets are printed out. Arrange the sheets so that they fit together (see extra page with the overview of the prints). Cut off the single sheets on the upper and right edge along the thin frame lines. Begin with the left lower sheet and then glue the parts in the frame lines together precisely. Cut out the patterns.

Step 3

Cut the pattern from thick felt twice

Before you remove the pattern from the fabric, please mark the cross lines using tailor's chalk. The dashed lines on the pattern show where the pattern pieces have to be sewn together.

Step 4

SEAM AND HEMLINE ALLOWANCES are included on an average:

1/4 inch (0.5 cm) for all edges. BURDA copying paper, transfer the lines and signs of the pattern onto the wrong side of the fabric. Instructions can be found in the packaging.

Sewing

While sewing, the right sides of the fabric are facing.

Transfer all lines of the pattern onto the right side of the fabric using basting stitches.

Step 5

Slipper

Pin the upper part of the slipper onto the slipper sole to make the seams 12 and 13 meet. Make sure that the outer edges of the upper part of the slipper and sole of the slipper are positioned exact. Stitch the upper part of the slipper onto the sole, \hat{A} ¼ inch from the edge, and further stitch the rest of the sole. Secure seam ends. Tip: use the one-sided edge stitching foot and sewing thread.

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
