Satin bustier. Note: This is the same pattern as Leather bustier #124 burda style magazine patterns FAQ

Materials

Cotton satin with crosswise stretch

Step 1 — Preparation



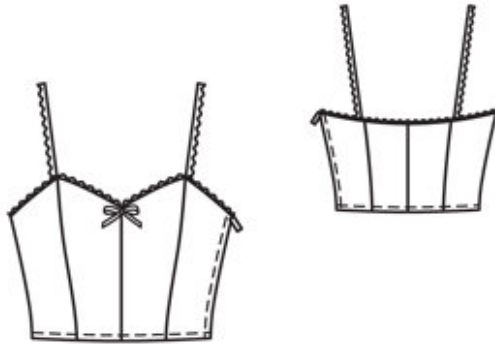
Paper cut for ANSI A (German DIN A4) prints:

This pattern is printed on 8.5 × 11 sheets of plain paper. Do not scale or center pages before printing. Wait until all sheets are printed out before beginning to tape them together. **Do not cut out pattern pieces yet**— Arrange the sheets on a large, hard, flat surface so that they fit together, matching up like numbers and letters (i.e. 6A to 6A). To tape pattern together, fold under the margin of one piece (6A) and tape right against the line of it's matching number/letter (6A).

burda style magazine pattern do not have seam allowance included.

Seam and hem allowances to be added: Seams and edges 1.5 cm (5/8 in).

Step 2 — Cutting out



- 1centre front 2x
- 2side front 2x
- 3centre back 2x
- 4side back 2x

Step 3 — Back

Stitch centre front and centre back seams and section seams. Begin centre front seam exactly at upper seam line. Press seam allowances open. Topstitch close to each side of seams. Stitch right side seam. Press seam allowances open.

Step 4 — Upper edge

On upper edge, trim allowance to 1 cm (3/8 in). Pin lace trim to upper edge so that scalloped edge of trim lies on garment piece, 5 mm (3/16 in) past seam line. Stitch lace trim in place, 5 mm (3/16 in) from fabric edge. Turn allowance to inside — scalloped edge of lace extends. Topstitch close to upper edge of garment.

Step 5 — Hem

Turn hem allowance to inside, turn edge under to a hem width of 1 cm (3/8 in), and stitch.

Step 6 — Zip

On left side edges, press allowances to inside. Turn in top ends of zip tapes. Stitch zip under edges so that zip teeth are covered.

Step 7 — Straps

Cut remainder of lace trim into two equal pieces, for the straps. Pin straps to upper edge of garment, next to front and back section seams. Try on garment to determine correct length of straps. Sew strap ends in place. Tie satin ribbon in a bow and sew to upper edge, at centre front.

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
