Maternity jacket. Made from cotton poplin. burda style magazine patterns FAQ

## Materials

Cotton poplin, fabric width: 145 cm (57 ins), fabric length: Size 36-38: 2.90 m (3 1/4 yds) Size 40: 2.95 m (3 3/8 yds) Size 42-44: 3.00 m (3 3/8 yds). Vilene/ Pellon G 785. 4 large sew-on snap fasteners.

## Step 1 — Preparations



Paper cut for ANSI A (German DIN A4) prints:

This pattern is printed on 8.5 × 11 sheets of plain paper. Do not scale or center pages before printing. Wait until all sheets are printed out before beginning to tape them together. **Do not cut out pattern pieces yet**— Arrange the sheets on a large, hard, flat surface so that they fit together, matching up like numbers and letters (i.e. 6A to 6A). To tape pattern together, fold under the margin of one piece (6A) and tape right against the line of it's matching number/letter (6A).

Burda sizes 36, 38, 40, 42, 44. The size chart for maternity clothes is the standard women's size chart. Compare your own measurements, except for waist measurement, with the size chart to determine your size.

Trace the pattern pieces from the pattern sheet. Tape pieces 21 and 21a together on joining lines. Lengthen piece 22 as indicated. Trace the pocket piece from piece 21 as a separate pattern piece, it is the same for all sizes.

The pleat arrows on pieces 21 and 22 are marked for size 36. For the other sizes, remark pleat arrows accordingly. The snap fasteners marked on piece 21 are for size 36. For the other sizes, mark the top snap the same distance from neck edge as for size 36. The bottom snap is the same for all sizes. Space the other snaps evenly in between.

**burda style magazine pattern do not have seam allowance included.**

Seam and hem allowances to be added: Seams and edges 1.5 cm (5/8 in), hem 5 cm (2 ins) (flare hem allowances), sleeve hems 5 cm (2 ins).

## Step 2 — Cutting out



Main fabric:

21 front, cut 2x

pocket piece, cut 4x

22 back, cut on a fold 1x

23 sleeve, cut 2x

24 standing collar, cut on a fold 1x

25 back facing, cut on a fold 1x

## Step 3 — Sewing

### Sew the jacket

Fold the inverted pleat at centre back in direction of arrows and press. Tack stitch the pleat to the upper edge. Fold the pleats in fronts in direction of arrows and baste.

Lay the front pieces right sides together with back piece, line up, pin and sew the side seams, not stitching across pocket openings. Line up, pin and stitch the shoulder seams.

Pin pocket the pieces right sides together with the seam allowances on pocket opening edges. Stitch in place, directly along the seam lines. Press pocket pieces forward and stitch together.

Turn hem allowance to inside, turn edge under, and stitch 3 cm (1 1/4 ins) from lower edge. Press pleat folds in hem edge.

### **Facings**

Stitch the back facing to the shoulder edges of the front self-facings. Trim the seam allowances on inner facing edge to 7 mm (1/4 in) wide, neaten the edge, press to inside, and stitch in place. Fold self-facings to inside. Tack facing to neck edge. Press the front edges. Sew front facings to hem edge. Topstitch 4 cm (1 5/8 ins) from front edges.

### **Collar**

Fold collar on the fold line, with right side facing in. Stitch the front edges together, beginning and ending the stitching exactly at seam line on joining edge. Turn collar right side out and press. Stitch outer collar piece to neck edge. Turn edge of inside collar piece under and stitch to joining seam

### **Sleeves**

Stitch sleeve seams. Fold and press the sleeve hem allowances to inside, turn raw edges under, and stitch. Set in sleeves. Turn the garment inside out and set in sleeves in each armhole, right sides facing each other, easing the sleeve caps. Pin the sleeve to the armhole and stitch around the armhole opening. Press the seam allowance out in to the sleeve.

### **Snaps**

Cover snap fastener halves with main fabric. Sew top halves of snaps to inside of right front, taking even stitches and exiting needle on right side of fabric. Sew bottom halves of snaps to left front edge to match.
