Waistcoat burda style magazine patterns FAQ

Materials

Genoa corduroy

Step 1 — Preparation



Paper cut for ANSI A (German DIN A4) prints:

This pattern is printed on 8.5 × 11 sheets of plain paper. Do not scale or center pages before printing. Wait until all sheets are printed out before beginning to tape them together. **Do not cut out pattern pieces yet**— Arrange the sheets on a large, hard, flat surface so that they fit together, matching up like numbers and letters (i.e. 6A to 6A). To tape pattern together, fold under the margin of one piece (6A) and tape right against the line of it's matching number/letter (6A).

burda style magazine pattern do not have seam allowance included.

Seam and hem allowances to be added: Seams and edges 1.5 cm (5/8 in).

Step 2 — Cutting out



Velvet/corduroy:

21 front 2x

â—’â—’ front facing 2x

23 side back 2x

a) 4 welt strips, cut on bias for view A and cut on straight grain for view B, 14 cm (5 1/2 ins) long, 4 cm (1 5/8 ins) wide (incl. allowances),

b) 2 pocket pieces, 14 cm (5 1/2 ins) wide, 8 cm (3 1/4 ins) long (incl. allowances).

Lining fabric:

22 centre back, on a fold 2x

c) right half-belt piece 13 cm (5 1/4 ins) long, left half-belt piece 22 cm (8 3/4 ins) long, each 5 cm (2 ins) wide, finished width 2.5 cm (1 in)

also piece 21, minus width of facing; piece 23; and pocket piece (piece b).

Interfacing: See pattern layout. Interface inside centre back piece. Iron strips of interfacing, approx. 3 cm (1 1/4 ins) wide, to wrong side of front, over pocket markings.

Step 3 — Darts

Stitch darts in fronts. Trim dart allowances to 1 cm (3/8 in) wide. Press open, pressing points of darts flat.

Step 4 — Welt pockets

Sew welt pockets on fronts: Hand baste along welt placement lines, 5 mm (3/16 in) from each welt joining line (= finished width of welt), to make these lines visible on right side of fabric. Fold welt strip lengthwise,

right side facing out, and press. Lay each folded welt strip on front piece, at upper joining line, and pin so that fold edge of welt meets placement line. Stitch welt in place, along joining line, 5 mm (3/16 in) from fold edge. Then stitch remaining welt to lower joining line in same manner. Slash between lines of stitching and clip diagonally toward each last stitch, not catching welts. Turn welts into pocket openings and press. Fold small triangles at pocket opening ends to inside and stitch to welts, from seam end to seam end. Stitch pocket lining pieces to seam allowances of lower joining seams and stitch pocket pieces of outer fabric to seam allowances of upper welt joining seams. Trim pocket pieces even and stitch together.

Step 5 — Half-belt

Fold the half-belt pieces lengthwise, right side facing in. Stitch along the long edges and across one end of each. Turn right side out. Baste the half-belt to centre back, between markings, with the shorter belt piece on the right and the longer belt piece on the left.

Step 6 — Seam allowances

Stitch side backs to centre back. Press seam allowances onto centre piece. Stitch shoulder seams. Press seam allowances onto back

Step 7 — Lining

Stitch front facings to front lining pieces. Stitch darts and seams of lining.

Step 8 — Facings

Pin facings and lining right sides together with waistcoat. Stitch along front and back hem edges, neck edge, and armhole edges. Trim seam allowances. To turn right side out, push fronts through shoulder tunnels, to back, then pull to outside, through an open side seam. Press edges.

Step 9 — Lining

Stitch side seams on outer fabric, also stitching a section of lining seam at top and bottom. Reach through one open lining seam to pull out the other lining side seam. Stitch open seam closed and push in place again. Sew second open seam by hand.

Step 10 — Buttonholes

Work buttonholes in right front. Fold end of right half-belt over bar of buckle, 2 cm (3/4 in) wide, and stitch.

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
