Dress with bow in back burda style magazine patterns FAQ

Materials

duchesse

Step 1 — Preparation

Trace the pattern pieces from the pattern sheet. Trace the pocket piece from piece 26 as a separate pattern piece — it is the same for all sizes.

Seam and hem allowances:

Seams and edges 1.5 cm (5/8 in).

Step 2 — Cutting out



Duchesse:

21upper front, on a fold 1x

— and as lining, on a fold 1x

22lower front, on a fold 1x

— and as lining, on a fold 1x

23centre back 2x

— and as lining 2x

24side back 2x

— and as lining 2x

25upper back with

— integrated tie band 2x

— and as lining 2x

26front skirt panel, on a fold 1x

— — pocket piece 2x

27back skirt panel 2x

Lining: pieces 26 and 27 and also —pocket piece (piece 26).

Vilene Bias Tape: Iron onto neck edge and armhole edges of upper front piece. Iron onto neck edge of upper back, from shoulder to centre back, and onto edges of armholes, from shoulder to marking.

Step 3 — Front and back

Stitch upper front to lower front. Stitch vertical back section seams. Stitch the (forwarded) side seams. Stitch shoulder seams (seam number 3). Press seam allowances open.

Step 4 — Lining

Sew lining as for dress bodice.

Step 5 — Skirt

Stitch skirt side seams, but do not stitch across pocket openings.

Step 6 — In-seam pockets

Pin pocket pieces right sides together with seam allowances of pocket opening edges — pocket lining pieces in front and pocket pieces of main fabric in back. Stitch pocket pieces in place, directly along marked seam lines. Press pocket pieces forward and stitch together

Step 7 — Skirt and bodice

Gather upper edge of skirt to fit edge of dress bodice. Stitch skirt to bodice. Press seam allowances up.

Step 8 — Zip

Sew invisible zip to back opening edges. Stitch centre back seam from lower edge to zip.

Step 9 — Lining

Stitch seams of skirt lining, leaving slit open for zip. Gather upper edge of skirt lining. Place skirt lining over skirt, with right sides facing. Stitch hem edges together. Trim seam allowances. Lay skirt lining down and stitch to seam allowances, close to seam. Turn skirt lining to inside and stitch to seam allowances of skirt joining seam, at slit stitching as far as possible. Turn in lining and sew to zip tapes.

Step 10 — Lining and zip

Lay bodice lining right sides together with dress bodice. Pin upper edges of centre and side backs, edges of armholes, tie bands, and neck edge together. At zip opening, turn lining back, about 5 mm (3/16 in) before edge of opening, and pin to upper edge. Lay allowances at edges of back opening outward and pin to upper edge, over lining. Stitch along edges, leaving centre and upper backs open between markings (seam number 5). Trim seam allowances and clip allowances of upper backs at markings. Turn lining to inside and turn tie bands right side out. Press edges. Slip open lower edges of upper backs into seam openings on upper edges of centre backs and pin. Reach between dress bodice and lining. Pull out open seam sections and stitch them closed. Turn in lining and sew to zip tapes and to skirt joining seam.

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
