Cropped Sweatshirt Jacket burda style magazine patterns FAQ

Materials

Sweatshirting

Step 1 — Preparation

Trace the pattern pieces from the pattern sheet. Trace the facing from piece 1 as a separate pattern piece.

Seam and hem allowances:

Seams and edges 1.5 cm (5/8 in), hem and sleeve hems 4 cm (15/8 ins), lining 1.5 cm (5/8 in).

Step 2 — Cutting Out



Sweatshirting:

1 front 2x

2 front facing 2x

3 back 2x

4 upper sleeve 2x

5 under sleeve 2x

6 collar, on a fold 2x

7 collar stand, on a fold 2x

8 back facing, on a fold 1x

Fine jersey (lining): piece 1 minus width of facing; piece 2 minus neck facing; pieces 3 and 4.

Interfacing: See pattern layout. Also interface hem allowances.

Step 3 — Note

Stitch seams on stretch fabrics with a special stretch stitch or at a narrow zigzag setting.

Step 4 — Darts

Stitch darts. Press vertical darts toward centre. Press bust darts down.

Step 5 — Stitch centre back seam, side seams and shoulder seams

Stitch centre back seam, side seams and shoulder seams. Stitch shoulder seams of facing. Press seam allowances open.

Step 6 — Notched collar

Pin facing right sides together with jacket. Pin lapel fold lines together. Build a little extra fullness into corners of lapels. Stitch facing to jacket, along lapel edges, from marking, and along front edges. Leave facing lying right sides together with jacket for the time being. Stitch collar stand pieces to collar pieces. Trim seam allowances and press open. Topstitch close to each side of seams. Stitch collar pieces together on outer edges, building a little extra fullness into top collar and beginning and ending stitching on narrow edges, exactly at seam line of joining edge. Turn collar right side out. Lay collar between jacket and facing. Stitch under collar to neck edge of jacket, from each seam mark to corner. Clip seam allowances of fronts into corners. Stitch long edge of undercollar to neck edge of jacket. Stitch top collar to facing, clipping seam allowances of facing into corners. Press seam allowances of collar joining -seams open. Turn facing to inside. Pin collar joining seams together exactly. Lay back facing up and stitch seam allowances together, close to collar joining seam. Lay facing down again.

Step 7 — Unfold facings at hem

Unfold facings at hem. Press hem allowance to inside but do not yet sew. Turn facings to inside again.

Step 8 — Stitch sleeve seams

Stitch sleeve seams. Press sleeve hem allowances to inside and sew in place by hand.

Step 9 — Set in sleeves, easing sleeve caps

Set in sleeves, easing sleeve caps. Sew shoulder pads in place.

Step 10 — Stitch darts and seams of lining

Stitch darts and seams of lining. Set in sleeve linings.

Step 11 — Line jacket, hem

Stitch lining to inside edges of facing, turning hem allowance down to stitch. Lay lining inside jacket, wrong sides facing, pulling sleeve linings into sleeves. Turn hem allowance to inside and sew in place by hand. Turn in lining along hem edge. Press fold edge lightly, push upward in a shallow curve, and pin to hem allowance. Sew lining in place. Lay extra length of lining down and press lightly. Pin a fold, about 1 cm (3/8 in) deep, in lining, above sleeve hems. Turn in sleeve lining and sew to hem allowance. Lay extra length of lining down and press.

Step 12 — Snaps

Cover snap fasteners with outer fabric. Sew top halves of snaps to right front facing, taking even stitches and exiting needle on right fabric side. Sew bottom halves of snaps to left front, to match.

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
