Dress with wide pockets burda style magazine patterns FAQ

Materials

Plaid linen

Step 1 — Preparation

Trace pattern pieces from the pattern sheet. Follow lines and details for style 125. Trace pocket piece from piece 8 as a separate pattern piece.

Seam and hem allowances:

Seams and edges 1.5 cm (5/8 in), hem and sleeve hems 4 cm (1 5/8 ins)

Step 2 — Cutting out



Linen:

1 centre front, on a fold 1x

2 side front 2x

3 centre back 2x

4 side back 2x

5 sleeve 2x

6 front skirt panel, on a fold 1x

7 upper side skirt panel with

— integrated pocket piece 2x

8 lower side skirt panel 2x

— pocket piece 2x

9 back skirt panel 2x

Lining: pieces 1 to 4.

Vilene Bias Tape/stay tape: Iron to neck edge. Also iron Vilene Bias Tape/ stay tape to pocket opening edges

of lower side skirt p

Step 3 — Bust Darts

Stitch bust darts. Press darts up. Stitch front and back section seams, side seams, and shoulder seams of dress bodice. Press seams open.

Step 4 — Pockets

Stitch pocket pieces right sides together with pocket opening edges of lower side skirt panels. Turn pocket pieces up and stitch to seam allowances, close to seam. Turn pocket pieces to inside. Pin pocket opening edges to upper side skirt panels. $\hat{\text{A}}$ Stitch lower edges of pocket pieces together. Baste pocket pieces to wrong side of side skirt panel edges.

Step 5 — Bodice

Stitch front and back section seams of skirt (seam numbers 8 and 9). Press seam allowances open. Lay $\hat{\text{A}}$ pleats in front skirt panel in direction of arrows and baste. Gather upper edges of side skirt panels to 18 $\hat{\text{a}}$ — 19 $\hat{\text{a}}$ — 20 $\hat{\text{a}}$ — 21 $\hat{\text{a}}$ — 22 cm (7 $\hat{\text{a}}$ — 7 1/2 $\hat{\text{a}}$ — 8 $\hat{\text{a}}$ — 8 3/8 $\hat{\text{a}}$ — 8 3/4 ins) and gather upper edges of back skirt panels to 8 $\hat{\text{a}}$ — 8.5 $\hat{\text{a}}$ — 9 $\hat{\text{a}}$ — 9.5 $\hat{\text{a}}$ — 10 cm (3 1/4 $\hat{\text{a}}$ — 3 3/8 $\hat{\text{a}}$ — 3 1/2 $\hat{\text{a}}$ — 3 3/4 $\hat{\text{a}}$ — 4 ins). Stitch skirt to dress bodice. Press $\hat{\text{A}}$ seam allowances up.

Step 6 — Zip

Sew invisible zip to edges of back slit. Stitch centre back seam from lower edge to zip.

Step 7 — Darts

Stitch darts and seams of lining. Pin lining right sides together with neck edge of dress. At zip slit, turn lining back, approx. 5 mm (3/16 in) before edge of slit, and pin to neck edge. At dress slit, turn allowances to outside and pin to neck edge, over lining. Stitch along neck edge. Turn allowances at slit edges to inside. Turn lining up and stitch to seam allowances, as far as possible, close to seam. Turn lining to inside, turn edges under, and sew to zip tapes and to skirt joining seam. Baste lining to edges of arm $\hat{\text{A}}$ holes.

Step 8 — Sleeve seams

Stitch sleeve seams. Press sleeve hem allowances to inside and sew in place by hand.

Step 9 — Sleeve caps

Set in sleeves, easing sleeve caps.

Step 10 — Hem

Press hem allowance to inside sew in place by hand.

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
