# Materials

Fulled loden

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## Step 1 — Preparation



Paper cut for ANSI A (German DIN A4) prints:â€œâ€œThis pattern is printed on 8.5 × 11 sheets of plain paper. Do not scale or center pages before printing. Wait until all sheets are printed out before beginning to tape them together. **Do not cut out pattern pieces yet**— Arrange the sheets on a large, hard, flat surface so that they fit together, matching up like numbers and letters (i.e. 6A to 6A). To tape pattern together, fold under the margin of one piece (6A) and tape right against the line of it’s matching number/letter (6A).

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## Step 2 — Cutting out



Fulled loden:

1—centre front 2x

2—front facing 2x

3—side front 2x

4—centre back 2x

5—side back 2x

6—collar, on a fold 2x

7—collar stand, on a fold 2x

8—back facing, on a fold 1x

9—upper sleeve 2x

10—under sleeve 2x

11—pocket, on a fold 2x

a) 2 pocket bands, 14 1/2" 14 1/2" 14 1/2" 15 1/2" 15 cm (5 1/2" 5 1/2" 5 1/2" 6 1/2" 6 ins) long, 4 cm (1 1/2 ins) wide, finished width 2 cm (3/4 in).

Lining : piece 1 minus width of facing; piece 3 minus width of facing and with an ease pleat of approx. 2 cm (3/4 in) at centre back; pieces 2, 4, 8, 9, and 10.

Interfacing: See pattern layout. Also interface hem allowances.

### Step 3 — Bust darts

Stitch bust darts. Cut darts open along the centre and press open, pressing points of darts flat.

## Step 4 — Seams

Stitch the centre back seam, front and back section seams, side seams, and shoulder seams. Stitch facing seams. Press seam allowances open.

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## Step 5 — Notched collar and front edges

Pin the facing right sides together with the jacket. Pin the lapel fold lines together. Build a little extra fullness into corners of lapels. Stitch facing to edges of lapels, from marking, and to front and hem edges, on hem edges leaving the last 6 cm (23/8 ins) before ends of facing open. Leave the facing lying right sides together with the jacket for now. Stitch collar stand pieces to collar pieces. Trim the allowances and press seams open. Topstitch close to each side of seams. Stitch the collar pieces together on outer edges, building a little extra fullness into top collar and beginning and ending on ends, exactly at seam line of joining edge. Turn collar right side out. Lay collar between jacket and facing. Stitch under collar to neck edge of jacket, from each marking to corner. Clip seam allowances of fronts into corners. Stitch long edge of under collar to neck edge of jacket. Stitch top collar to facing, clipping seam allowances of facing into corners. Press allowances of collar joining seams open. Turn facing to inside. Press hem allowance to inside but do not yet sew. Pin collar joining seams together exactly. Turn back facing up and stitch seam allowances together, close to collar joining seam. Turn facing down again.

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## Step 6 — Patch pockets

Fold pleats in upper edges of pockets in direction of arrows and baste. Stitch bands to upper pocket edges. Fold pleats in pocket lining pieces in direction of arrows and press. Stitch pocket lining pieces to opposite long edges of bands. Press seam allowances onto lining. Fold bands in half lengthwise and press, wrong side facing in. Lay pocket lining pieces on pockets, with wrong side facing, and baste. Neaten seam allowances. Embroider blanket stitches, 1 cm (3/8 in) long, along upper edges of pocket bands, spacing stitches 1 cm (3/8 in) apart. Gather side and lower edges of pockets between asterisks to 25 â€ 25 â€ 25 â€ 26 â€ 26 cm (10 â€ 10 â€ 10 â€ 10 1/4 â€ 10 1/4 ins). Pocket edges should turn to inside when gathering threads are pulled. Pin lower pocket edges to hem line and to abutting lines as far as possible, right sides facing â€ pockets point down. Stitch pocket edges in place. Turn pockets up, turn remaining edges under, and sew in place by hand.

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## Step 7 — Sleeves

Stitch sleeve seams. Fold pleats in sleeves in direction of arrows and baste. Press sleeve hem allowances to inside and sew in place by hand.

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## Step 8 — Shoulder pads

Set in sleeves. Sew shoulder pads in place.

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## Step 9 — Sew lining

On centre back lining pieces, stitch allowances of centre seam together, 1 cm (3/8 in) from edge. For the ease pleat, stitch along centre back, approx. 5 cm long, at upper and lower edges, and baste in between. Press pleat to one side. Stitch darts and seams of lining. Set in sleeve linings.

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## Step 10 — Line jacket, hem jacket

Stitch lining to inside edges of facing, turning hem allowance of facings down. Lay lining inside jacket with wrong sides together, pulling linings into sleeves. Turn hem allowance to inside and sew in place by hand. Turn in lining along lower edge of jacket. Press fold edge lightly, push upward in a shallow curve, and pin to hem allowance. Sew facings and lining in place. Lay extra length of lining down and press lightly. Turn in edges of sleeve linings and sew to hem allowance.

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## Step 11 — Buttonholes

Work buttonholes in right front. Work top buttonhole for inside button in left front.

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## Step 12 — Blanket stitch

Beginning at pocket, work blanket stitch along front hem edge, front edge, edges of lapels and collar. Also work blanket stitch along lower sleeve edges — stitch length and spacing 1 cm (3/8 in).

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
