Furr hat burda style magazine patterns FAQ

Materials

Fake fur

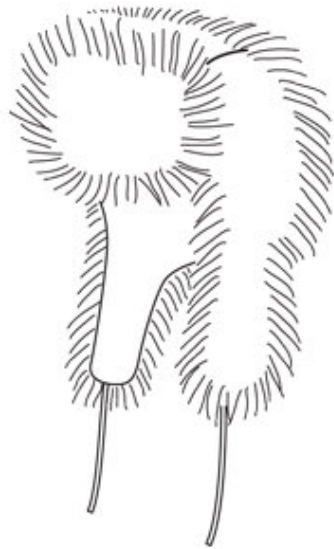
Step 1 — Preparation



This pattern is printed on 8.5 × 11 sheets of plain paper. Do not scale or center pages before printing. Wait until all sheets are printed out before beginning to tape them together. **Do not cut out pattern pieces yet**— Arrange the sheets on a large, hard, flat surface so that they fit together, matching up like numbers and letters (i.e. 6A to 6A). To tape pattern together, fold under the margin of one piece (6A) and tape right against the line of it's matching number/letter (6A).

burda style magazine pattern do not have seam allowance included.
Seam and hem allowances to be added: Seams and edges 1.5 cm (5/8 in).

Step 2 — Cutting out



Fake fur:

21side hat piece 2x

22centre hat piece, on a fold 1x

23visor 2x

When cutting, cut only the fabric backing and not the hairs of the fur.

Sweatshirting (lining):

pieces 21 and 22.

Step 3 — Note

When stitching seams, push the hairs of the fur toward the garment piece. Be careful when pressing fake fur. Test-iron a scrap of fabric first. You can also smooth seam allowances open with your hand, then baste them in place with long stitches. if needed.

Step 4 — Side and visor

Stitch side hat pieces to centre piece (seam number 1). Lay visor pieces right sides facing. Stitch outer edges together. Trim seam allowances. Turn visor right side out and press. Baste joining edges of visor together to front edge of hat, between seam marks (seam number 3).

Step 5 — Tie bands

For the tie bands, cut leather band into four equal pieces. Lay pairs of bands together, wrong sides facing. Glue together with glue stick. Topstitch close to edges. Baste bands to lower edges of side hat pieces, between seam marks.

Step 6 — Lining

Stitch seams of lining, leaving an opening, approx. 15 cm (6 ins) long, in one seam, for turning. Lay lining right sides together with hat. Stitch edges together, catching bands and visor. Turn right side out. Place lining inside hat, wrong sides facing. Sew seam opening closed.

Step 7 — Visor

Turn visor up onto hat and hold in place at each seam, with a thread bar.

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
