Peasant blouse with tie front burda style magazine patterns FAQ Please note that the pattern contains longer sleeves than what is featured in the project image. To adjust your sleeve, simply hem to the desired length.

Materials

Batiste

Step 1 — Preparation



Trace the pattern pieces from the pattern sheet.

Seam and hem allowances:

Seams 1.5 cm (5/8 in), all other edges without allowance.

Step 2 — Cutting Out



21front, on a fold 1x

22back, on a fold 1x

23sleeve 2x

a) frill, cut on bias, a total of 2.40 m (2.40 m — 2.45 m — 2.45 m — 2.50 m (25/8 m — 25/8 m — 23/4 m — 23/4 m — 23/4 yds) long (incl. 55 cm / 22 ins at both ends for the tie bands), 4 cm (15/8 ins) wide.

Step 3 — Pleat folds

Hand-baste along marked pleat folds on front, back and sleeve pieces to make these lines visible on right side of fabric.

Step 4 — Pleats

Fold front and back each on marked pleat folds, wrong side facing in, and baste along marked stitching lines (or machine stitch at a long setting). Work from the centre to press pleats to each side. Stitch across pleats at ends and 3 cm (1 1/4 ins) below neck edge. Also stitch pleats 7 mm (1/4 in) from neck edge. Remove pleat basting.

Step 5 — Sleeve pleats

Fold sleeves on pleat fold lines, with wrong side facing in. Topstitch fold edges from top to markings. Work from centre of sleeve to press front pleats forward and back pleats toward back.

Step 6 — Stitch side seams, shoulder seams and sleeve seams

Stitch side seams, shoulder seams and sleeve seams. Topstitch 7 mm (1/4 in) from hem edges of blouse and sleeves. The edges can be allowed to fray.

Step 7 — Frill

Stitch frill pieces together. Measure and mark 55 cm (22 ins) for tie bands at each end of frill. Gather frill along the centre, between markings, to match neck edge. Stitch frill to blouse with centre of frill positioned 7 mm (1/4 in) below neck edge. Begin and end stitching about 5 mm (3/16 in) before centre front and leave tie bands extending.

Step 8 — Set in sleeves, easing sleeve caps

Set in sleeves, easing sleeve caps.
