Front scarf dress burda style magazine patterns FAQ

Materials

stretch jersey

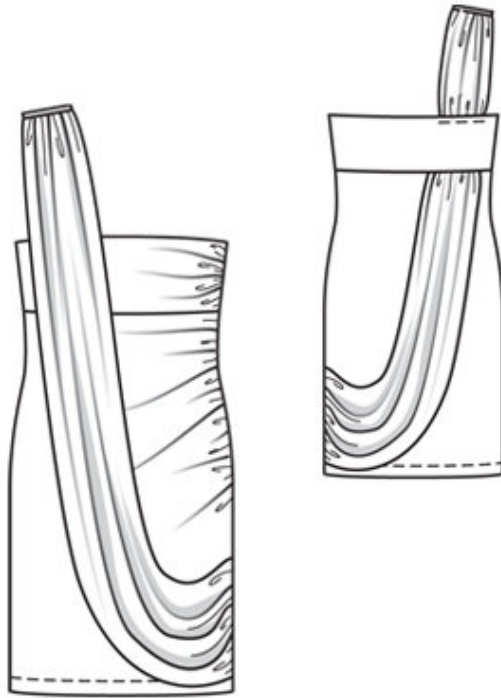
Step 1 — Preparation

Trace the pattern pieces from the pattern sheet. Trace piece 25 from the pattern sheet twice — once to the line — front scarf — (front scarf piece) and once to the line — back scarf — (back scarf piece). Glue pieces 25 and 25a together on the joining lines.

Seam and hem allowances:

Seams and edges 1.5 cm (5/8 in), hem 4 cm (1 5/8 ins).

Step 2 — Cutting out



Stretch jersey:

21 upper front 1x

22 lower front 1x

23 upper back, on a fold 1x

24 lower back, on a fold 1x

Fine jersey:

25 front scarf piece, on a fold 1x

25 back scarf piece, on a fold 1x

a) narrow band, 12 cm (4 3/4 ins) long, 3 cm (1 1/4 ins) wide (incl. allowance).

Step 3 — Scarf

Fold scarf pieces lengthwise, right side facing in. Stitch long edges together. Turn scarf pieces right side out. Press edges. Gather lower edge of scarf pieces to 24 cm (9 1/2 ins). Gather front scarf piece along upper edge and also to each side of marked shoulder line to a width of 10 cm (4 ins). Gather upper edge of back scarf piece to 12 cm (4 3/4 ins).

Step 4 — Scarf front and back

Gather lower front between asterisks to 30 cm (12 ins). Baste lower edge of front scarf piece to left side seam edge of lower front, between markings. Baste back scarf piece to lower back: lower edge of scarf between markings on left side seam edge and upper edge between markings on right half of upper edge. Lay lower front and back right sides together. Stitch side seams. Trim seam allowances to 1 cm (3/8 in) wide, neaten

together and press onto back.

Step 5 — Side seams and lower edges

Gather upper front between asterisks to a length of 12 cm (4 3/4 ins). Stitch side seams. Fold upper front and back on fold line, wrong side facing in, and press. Baste lower edges together. Stitch upper front and back to lower front and back. Press seam allowances up.

Step 6 — Narrow band

Press ends of narrow band to inside, 1 cm (3/8 in) wide, then fold band in half lengthwise and press. Lay narrow band on front scarf piece so that open edges meet marked shoulder seam line and fold edge points down. Stitch narrow band in place, 5 mm (3/16 in) from edge, lay up over seam, and pin. Topstitch band close to all edges. Baste upper edge of front scarf piece under right half of upper back edge, between markings. Work from right side of fabric to stitch close to edge and again 7 mm (1/4 in) from edge.

Step 7 — Hem Allowance

Press hem allowance to inside. Stitch from right side with the twin machine needle, 2.5 cm (1 in) from the lower edge.

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
