Step 1 — Preparation

Trace the pattern pieces from the pattern sheet. Follow lines and details for style 109. Glue pieces 1 and 1a and pieces 2 and 2a together on the joining lines. Cut piece 1 apart on the marked seam line = front and front band with self-facing. Trace the pocket piece from piece 1 as a separate pattern piece — it is the same for all sizes.

The buttonholes on piece 1 are marked for size 38. For sizes 40 — 46, mark the top buttonhole the same distance from neck edge as for size 38. The bottom buttonhole is the same for all sizes. Space the other buttonholes evenly in between.

Front lining piece: Glue front and front band together again. Fold front self-facing onto front and mark lining line along inside edge of facing. Trace front up to lining line.

Seam and hem allowances:

Seams and edges 1.5 cm (5/8 in), hem 4 cm (15/8 ins), lining 1.5 cm (5/8 in).

Step 2 — Cutting out

a) 2 sleeve bands, 22 — 22.5 — 23 — 23.5 — 24 cm (83/4 — 9 — 91/8 — 91/4 — 91/2 ins) long, 5 cm (2 ins) wide, finished width 2.5 cm (1 in),

b) belt, 100 — 104 — 108 — 112 — 116 cm (39 1/2 — 41 — 42 1/2 — 44 1/4 — 45 3/4 ins) long, 4 cm (1 1/2 ins) wide, finished width 2 cm (3/4 in).

Lining: front as instructed under — Preparation — ; piece 2 minus width of facing and with an ease pleat of about 2 cm (3/4 in) at centre back; — pieces 3 and 4; and pocket piece — (piece 1) four times.

Interfacing: See pattern layout. Also interface hem allowances. Iron buckram/ pelmet interfacing onto belt.

Step 3 — Darts

Stitch centre back seam and back darts. Press centre seam allowances open. Cut each dart along centre to about 5 cm (2 ins) before pointed end. Press darts open, pressing points flat.

Step 4 — Front bands and buttonholes

Stitch front bands to fronts. Press seam allowances open. Work buttonholes in right self-facing.

Step 5 — Front darts and in-seam pockets with welts

Stitch each interfaced welt piece to welt piece with no interfacing, right sides together, leaving joining edge open. Trim seam allowances. Turn welts right side open. Work a buttonhole in each. Stitch welts to front dart line, from marking to marking — welts point forward. Stitch darts in fronts but do not stitch across pocket openings. Trim allowances of wide darts to width of seam allowances. Press welts to the side. Press seam allowances open, pressing point of dart flats. Stitch pocket pieces to seam allowances of pocket opening edges. Trim pocket pieces even and stitch together. Sew narrow edges of welts in place by hand.

Step 6 — Side seams

Stitch side seams and shoulder seams.

Step 7 — Facings

Unfold front self-facings and stitch to back facing. Stitch facing to neck edge, from each front edge (fold) to centre front. Leave facings lying right sides together with coat for now.

Step 8 — Collar with collar band

Stitch collar band pieces to collar pieces (seam number 2). Trim seam allowances and press open. Topstitch close to each side of seams. Lay collar pieces right sides together. Stitch along outer edges from seam number 3 beginning and ending stitching exactly at seam line of joining edge. Trim seam allowances. Turn collar right side out and press. Lay collar between coat and facing. Stitch undercollar to neck edge of coat and stitch top collar to facing. Press seam allowances open. Turn facing to inside. Pin collar joining seams together. In back, lay facing up again and stitch allowances together, close to collar joining seam.

Step 9 — Hem

Unfold facings at hem. Press hem allowance to inside but do not yet sew in place. Turn facings to inside again.

Step 10 — Sleeves

Stitch sleeve seams. Gather lower edges of sleeves to match sleeve bands.

Step 11 — Sleeve bands

Stitch narrow ends of each sleeve band together. Stitch sleeve bands to lower edges of sleeves, matching seam of sleeve bands to front sleeve seams. Press seam allowances of joining seams onto sleeve bands. Fold sleeve bands half to inside and baste over joining seam, without turning raw edge under. Work from right side of garment to stitch along line of joining seam.

Step 12 — Sleeve caps

Set in sleeves, easing sleeve caps. Sew shoulder pads in place.

Step 13 — Sew lining

Stitch allowances of centre seam on back lining pieces together, 1 cm (3/8 in) from edge. To form ease pleat, stitch along centre back, about 5 cm (2 ins) long, at both upper and lower edges, and baste in between. Press pleat to one side. Stitch darts and seams of lining. Set in sleeve linings.

Step 14 — Line coat, hem

Stitch lining to inside edges of facing, laying hem allowance down. Lay lining inside coat with wrong sides facing, pulling linings into sleeves. Turn hem allowance to inside and sew in place by hand. Turn in lining along hem edge, press fold edge lightly, push upward in a shallow curve, and pin to hem allowance. Sew lining in place. Lay extra length of lining down and press lightly. Turn in sleeve lining and sew to sleeve hem allowance. Lay extra length down and press.

Turn in sleeve linings and sew to inside edges of sleeve bands.

Step 15 — Button

Sew a thread loop for the small button at upper corner of right front. Sew button to left front to match.

Step 16 — Belt

Fold belt lengthwise, right side facing in. Stitch lengthwise edges together. Position seam along centre of belt. Press seam open. Trim one end of belt to a point. Stitch pointed end of belt. Turn belt right side out and press. Fold straight end of belt over bar of buckle and stitch in place.

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
