Hoodie Turned Dino

I made this hoodie adjustment for my 2 year old son using a simple (bought) grey hoodie and a piece of thin felt. He's easier to spot on the playground wearing this!

Step 1 — Triangles



Take a of paper and draw desired size triangle. Then duplicate the triangle (mirror) and cut out the rhombus shape. Place shape on felt and cut a many pieces that you want dinosaur spikes.

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Step 2 — Put in place



Attach all the shapes on the back of the hoodie with needles.

Step 3 — Sew



Sew in the middle alongside the entire row of shapes. Remove needles when everything is in place.

Step 4 — Join triangles

Step 1 — Triangles 2



Join all the triangle shapes, either by a light hand stitch or on your machine. I used zig-zag.

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
